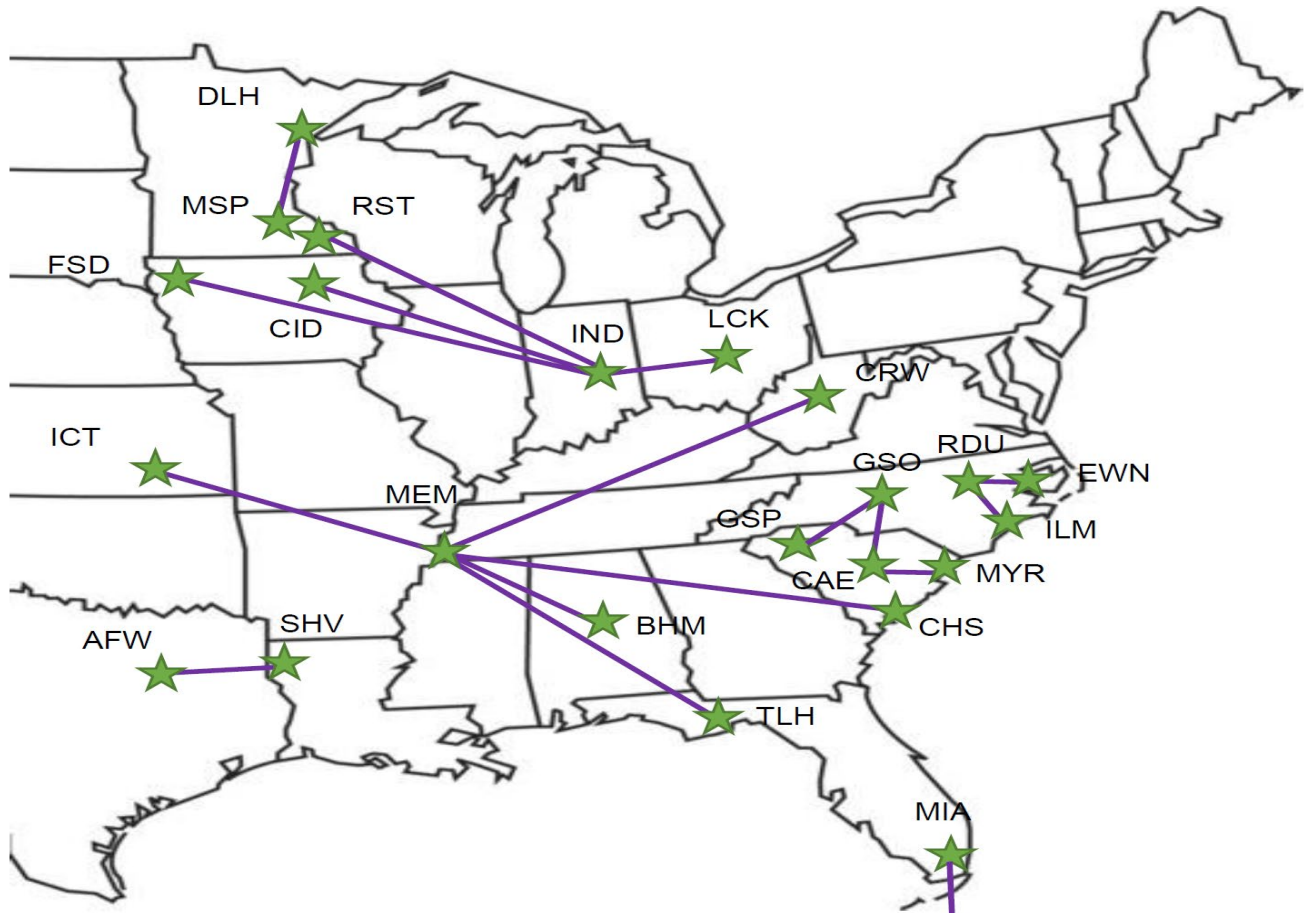


# STANDARD MAC ROUTES AND TIMES

The jumpseat is available to certificated flight deck crewmembers of airlines which participate in CASS. A reservation may be made 24 hours in advance of scheduled flight departure time and must be made no later than 2 hours prior to scheduled flight departure time. There is no walk-up jumpseat availability inside the two-hour cutoff and ramp access will be denied without a reservation. The offline jumpseat reservation number, **(828) 466 6763**, is available from 06:00 (local Eastern time) Monday through noon (local Eastern Time) Saturday and is available from 3 PM until 9 PM on Sunday. This will connect you with Operations. We request that you please cancel any reservation you do not intend to use. Clean, neat, casual attire is allowed: no shorts, T-shirts, or spiked heels.

One jumpseat is available on both the ATR 42 and ATR 72 and is awarded on a first come-first served basis. Because there is only one jumpseat on Mountain Air Cargo aircraft, there is a slim possibility that an approved jumpseater may be bumped if the jumpseat is unexpectedly required to transport a pilot or mechanic due to internal need. As stated, the likelihood of this situation is remote but all jumpseaters need to be aware of the possibility.
